



Permit for Swimming Pools

Over the years, Adams Township has attempted to inform pool companies that a building permit ***must be*** obtained before any swimming pool installation. As per the current building code, the 2006 IRC Appendix G, a swimming pool is defined as any pool that can hold more than 24 inches of water. These requirements are for all of Pennsylvania including Adams Township.

No swimming pool can be installed in Adams Township without a building permit. Aside from the building code issues there are zoning requirements that must be followed and through the permit process we can determine zoning compliance.

Adams Township must make sure a building permit is issued and in addition the required inspections must be scheduled and completed. Please feel free to contact the building department (724-625-1827) if you have any questions.
