

A special meeting of the Adams Township Board of Supervisors was held on June 28, 2016, at 6:30 p.m. at the Adams Township Municipal Building, 690 Valencia Road, Adams Township, Mars, PA for the purpose of discussions of a library building.

Present at the meeting were Supervisors Donald C. Aiken, Linda E. Lees, Edward L. Vogel, and Thomas L. Franceschina; and Township Secretary Janet Lubbert.

Chairman Aiken called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The Supervisors discussed the possibility of building a new library in the park. They discussed whether the building would be built by the township and leased or if it would be built by the library and the location of the building. They also discussed how much the township would contribute, the possibility of a \$500,000 Keystone grant and how much the library would get for the sale of the existing building.

The Supervisors discussed the need for a new guardrail on Carriage Hill Drive.

The meeting was adjourned by common consent at 7:00 p.m.
