

WAR MEMORIAL

In memory of our fallen soldiers, whose names are on the Adams War Memorial Monument.

Sgt. Elmer McClelland

Staff Sgt. Elmer McClelland, 105 Jefferson street, was killed in action November 5, according to word received by relatives from the war department. Previously he had been reported as missing. Sgt. McClelland graduated from Evans City high school in the class of 1938. Surviving at the time of his death was his mother, Mrs. John Teets, Rochester, Pa., two sisters, Mrs. James McCall, Evans City, Mrs. David Smith, Aliquippa and a brother, Harry McClelland of Mars.

He was a graduate of Kessler Field, Miss. Las Vegas, N. M. gunnery school and attended radio schools at Moses Lake, Wash., Rapid City, S.D. and Scott Field, Ill. When he went overseas, he was assigned to a B-17 bomber. He was home on furlough for days last Aug. He was crew chief of the bomber.

Private Robert W. Miller

Just one year and five days after he left Butler for army service, Private First Class Robert W. Miller, Ir. aged 20, son of Mr. & Mrs. R. W. Miller of Meridian R. D 7 was killed in action while serving in Italy. The official communication from the war department stated that Private Miller was killed in action on February 18, 1944, while serving with the armed forces in Italy. Private Miller was a graduate of the Butler Senior High school and a member of the varsity basketball team and vice president of his class. He was active in numerous school organizations and was chosen a Junior Rotarian. Before entering the service, he was attending Westminster College and was a member of the college choir and the Alpha Sigma Phi fraternity. He was a member of the Meridian United Presbyterian Church. The local infantryman was stationed at Camp Croft., S. C. for thirteen weeks before leaving for overseas duty. No details of the action in which Private Miller lost his life were given. He leaves his parents, Mr. & Mrs. Robert W Miller, Sr., and a brother, Private First Class M. Hugh Miller who is stationed Aberdeen, MD.
