#### ADAMS TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY DAY

#### WAR MEMORIAL

"All gave some but some gave all"

#### **GSGT HAROLD EUGENE MORROW**

Born May30, 1931 in Valencia, PA. Served in the United States Marine Corps. He was an Infantry Unit Leader with the 3<sup>rd</sup> BN, 26<sup>th</sup> Marines, 3<sup>rd</sup> Mardiv, III MAF. He was 36 yrs. old when he died on July 21, 1967 in the Quang Tri Province, South Vietnam. He died from small arms fire.

#### **SP4 WALTER EDWARD BARNES**

Born on December 13, 1948 in Evans City, PA. Served in the United States Army. He was in the Infantry B Co, 5<sup>th</sup> BN 7<sup>th</sup> Cavalry, 1<sup>st</sup> Cav Div USARV. He was 21 years old when he died on January 17, 1969 in Tay Ninh Province, South Vietnam. He died from small arms fire.

#### **SGT THOMAS RALPH BIERLINE**

Born on February 14,1948 in Zelienople, PA. Served in the United States Army. He was in the D TRP, 7<sup>th</sup> SQDN, 17<sup>TH</sup> CAVALRY, 1<sup>ST</sup> AVIATION BDE. He was 22 years old when he died on November 19, 1970 in Pleiku Providence, South Vietnam. He died from non-hostile casualty.

#### PFC WILLIAM ROGER CAMPBELL

Born on November 12, 1948 in Butler, PA. Served in the United States Marine Corps as a rifleman. He was in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Plt, E CO, 2<sup>ND</sup> BN, 26<sup>TH</sup> MARINES, 3<sup>RD</sup> MARDIV, III MAF. He died on June 6, 1968 in Quang Tri Province, South Vietnam. He died from small arms fire.

#### SPC GARY RICHARD GEORGE

Born on June 3, 1948 in Renfrew, PA. Served in the United States Army. He was an Infantryman and was in D Co,  $3^{rd}$  BN,  $21^{st}$  INFANTRY,  $196^{TH}$ 

INFANTRY BDE, AMERICAN DIV. He was 20 years old when he died on March 7, 1969 in Quang Tin Province, South Vietnam. He died from small arms fire.

### ADAMS WAR MEMORIAL SERVICE May 19, 2019 at 2:00 P.M.

The Bantam Marines Detachment #743 will post the colors and retire them. They will also do the gun salute and the playing of the taps. This group of Veterans is known for their "Toys for Tots" campaign in Butler and they also do many memorial services.

The Cranberry Barbershop Chorus, will sing the National Anthem and the Armed Forces Medley. Also, the laying of wreaths will be laid by two Veterans who served during the Korean War.

We need to remember the importance of Memorial Day. Our purpose in having this ceremony is to salute our Veterans. We want to remind everyone of all ages what our Veterans go through in order to give us Freedom.


If you have never attended these services, you will find they are heartfelt and patriotic.

# WHAT CAN I RECYCLE?

Items that are recyclable in 2019:

Please note: Before disposing of these items, make sure to remove all lids and rinse the containers until they are free of all food or chemical waste.

- Aluminum cans
- Aluminum foil
- Steel and tin food cans
- Corrugated cardboard
- Office paper
- Newspapers
- Paperboard
- #1 plastics (like water, juice, and salad dressing containers)
- #2 plastics (like milk, laundry detergent, and shampoo containers)

#### Other Items that are frequently put into recycling that should not be:

- #3 plastics (like kitchen plastic wrap, plumbing products, and the exterior packaging of most consumer goods)
- #4 plastics (like grocery bags, squeezable food containers, and garment bags)
- #5 plastics (like yogurt containers, butter containers, snack food bags, and plastic cups and straws)
- #6 plastics (like egg cartons, plastic utensils, and most takeout containers)
- #7 plastics (like reusable water bottles, CD cases, and electrical components)
- Pizza boxes
- Paper towels
- Toilet paper
- Diapers
- Foam packaging
- Window glass
- Heat resistant glass (like Pyrex)
