

FREE COVID-19 TESTING SITE THIS WEEK IN BUTLER

PA Department of Health Testing Site

The PA Department of Health will bring a COVID-19 test site to Butler for five days beginning Wednesday, December 2, and running to Sunday December 6th at Michelle Krill Field, 100 Pullman Park Pl, Butler PA 16001. The site is both a drive-thru and indoor walk-in testing clinic and will be open each of the above days from 9am until 6pm. Up to 450 patients can be tested per day. Mid-nasal passage swab PCR tests will be performed. Testing is on a first-come, first-serve basis and is completely free to all patients. Patients must be ages three and older and are not required to show symptoms of COVID-19 in order to be tested. No appointment is necessary. Patients are encouraged to bring a photo-ID or insurance card. Registration will also be completed on-site. The turnaround time for testing results is two to seven days after testing.
